ITSNJ Awards are given in the following categories:

Outstanding Project or Program

- Statewide/Regional Agency (Design and Construction)
- Local Public Agency (Design and Construction)

Public Agency Official

Professional

Young Professional

Submission are limited to three projects per agency. Each public agency should vet all projects being submitted on their behalf and select a maximum of three. Appropriate Public Agency MUST sign-off on all submissions. To be eligible, nominees must work, do business, or be located within the State of New Jersey. Non-winning prior year entries may be resubmitted. Criteria and submittal requirements are shown on the back of this page.

Submission Requirements/Award Criteria

Project or Program

Nominations for **Outstanding Project or Program** must include:

- **Executive Summary:** Briefly summarize the main aspects of the project. The Executive Summary shall not exceed one (1) page, printed in font size no smaller than 10-point. The Executive Summary shall be in an "article" format.
- **Project Description:** Describe the project and address the four categories for purposes of scoring and judging, as listed below. The Project description should not exceed 1,500 words.
- **Display Panel (saved as PDF):** The Display Panel should be suitable for printing as a 36" x 48" poster and include a graphical representation of the project. The Panel should clearly identify the name of the project and be visually pleasing while clearly outlining project/program and its value. A printed poster is not required at the time of submission.
- **Credits:** The entrant must provide a list of credits including Project Owner/Lead Agency, Prime Contractor, and other significant contributors. Appropriate Public Agency must sign-off on submission.

Selections will be based on the highest composite score of the following ranking criteria:

1. Uniqueness/originality of innovation
2. Demonstrated Need
3. Social, or economic sustainability
4. Future Value to the Engineering Profession and Perception by the Public

Individuals

Nominations for **Public Agency Official, Professional, or Young Professional** must include:

- **Statement:** Submissions shall include a statement on how the individual meets the evaluation criteria listed below (not to exceed 1,500 characters).
- **Photo of Nominee:** Submissions must include photo of the nominee.
- **A resume** may be submitted, but the total of supplemental documents must not exceed five (5) pages.

Individual Award categories will be evaluated based upon the following ranking criteria:

1. Notable accomplishment
2. Excellence of achievement
3. Contribution to ITS community
4. Involvement with ITSNJ or other professional organizations
